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Dear Owner / Rider / Person Responsible,

The purpose of this Medication Logbook is to serve as a record of <u>each and every</u> medication, listed on the FEI list of Prohibited Substances, given to the horse.

It is an FEI rule that every horse that is registered with the FEI is required to have this Logbook maintained as a detailed register.

The Logbook will enable the FEI to check what medications have been administered to the horse as required. This information may be required by the FEI in the case of an alleged violation of FEI Rules, especially the Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations.

This record must remain with the FEI Passport or the National Identification Document at all times but especially when attending an FEI event. Each medication administered must be entered in the Logbook without delay including details of the treating vet.

The completion of this Logbook is a compulsory requirement for all horses registered with the FEI and competing in FEI competition.

### **Medication and Treatment Record**

This information is compulsory for horses which have been administered medication both in and out of competition. It is particularly important to keep clear records of any treatment which includes an active substance that is currently on the FEI Prohibited Substances List.
